Dear Parents and Carers

A huge welcome to all of our children and their families! We hope you all had a fabulous summer holiday and we are very excited for the year ahead! A special welcome to all of the new children that have started our Foundation Stage Unit - we hope you enjoy your time here at Brompton.

## "Who am I? What will I be?"

For this term, our main focus is getting the children settled and into their new routines. We will be working on building relationships and friendships and continuing to promote the school driver 'Legacy'. We will be focussing most of our adult led learning through the Legacy principle of 'Know Yourself'. We will also be looking at the following stories - The Colour Monster. In Our Hands, What jobs could you do? The busiest people ever. What do people do all day?

## F1 Reading

F1 children will soon start to choose a different story book to take home every day - please make sure these are returned the next day so that they can be changed daily. It would be really helpful if all F1 children could have a school book bag to put their book, paintings and drawings in to take home. These can be bought from the school office at a cost of £7.00



## F2 Reading

The children need to bring in their reading book and reading record every day please. Their phonics book is to be read each day with a grown up and will be changed every Friday. They also have the opportunity to choose a "sharing book" which can be changed as often as they like. Please complete the reading record each time you read with your child.

All F2 children will need to have a book bag as we do not have the space to hang other bags and rucksacks. These can be purchased from the school office at a cost of £7.00

## Winter is coming...

Winter is fast approaching and with that in mind, please make sure all children have a sensible coat and sensible shoes for school. All children will need a waterproof coat for lunchtime and when playing outside. If you are able to provide a pair of wellies for your child this would be helpful as they are asked to change footwear when playing in the sandpit. In addition, F1 children will be taking part in listening walks around the school grounds and sometimes the grass can be very wet on a morning.

***Please make sure all items of clothing and footwear are clearly named.***

## Outdoor Learning - beginning Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2023

Every Friday morning all the children will take part in outdoor learning in our bushcraft area. We will go outside whatever the weather so children will need to come to school in suitable clothing such as puddle suits, wellies and warm clothing (uniform need not be worn). They will need indoor shoes and a complete change of clothing as sometimes we do get very wet and muddy! F2 children will need to bring their uniforms to change into for the afternoon session.

## **F2 P.E.**

The F2 children will have already started their P.E. sessions on Tuesdays. Could we ask that P.E. kit is brought in a drawstring bag as there is not much room in the cloakroom for rucksacks and large bags. P.E. kits are to be brought in on Monday and stay in school all week as sometimes our timetable changes. Please ensure your child has a white T shirt, a pair of black shorts and P.E. shoes.

*Please make sure **all** items in P.E. kits are clearly labelled with your child's name.*

## **F1 P.E.**

The F1 children will begin having P.E. sessions shortly. F1 children do not need P.E. kits and we ask that they come to school in more suitable clothing like shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms. Their school t-shirt will be fine for their sessions. No football kits please. We will let you know which day this will be soon.

## **Seesaw online learning platform**

Seesaw is our online learning platform that we use regularly to communicate with parent and carers as well as sharing the children's learning and 'wow' moments.

Log in information has been distributed to F2 parents and will go out for F1 parents in the next few weeks. Please do sign up as homework activities and key information is often shared through this platform.

## **Please note...**

- **ALL** items of clothing, footwear, coats and bags must be clearly labelled with your child's name. We cannot return items otherwise
- Please keep us informed and up to date of any medical/allergy information (including inhalers) concerning your child.
- Please could we ask for water only in children's water bottles.
