

Mathematics:

Place Value

Represent and partition numbers within 1000, count in 50s and 100s, find 100 more or less, estimate, order and compare numbers to 1000 making use of number lines

Addition and Subtraction

Add a 2 digit number to a 3 digit number, subtract a 2 digit number from a 3 digit number, complements to 100, inverse operations, estimating

Multiplication and Division

4 and 8 times tables and link between doubling and doubling again for 8 times. Times by ten and half it for x5 - corresponding division facts. Recognise can be done in any order when multiplying.

English, Communication and Language:

Our writing links to our current book *The Green Ship* and our next book *Ice Palace*.

Fiction: character descriptions, setting descriptions, re-tell
Non-Fiction: Diary entry, letters to home

French: French Greetings with puppets: Children will learn simple French greeting using puppets to role play.

French adjectives of colour, size and shape: Children will learn how to describe things using colours, size and shapes - play games and sing songs.

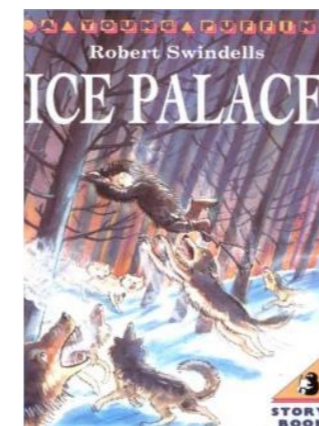
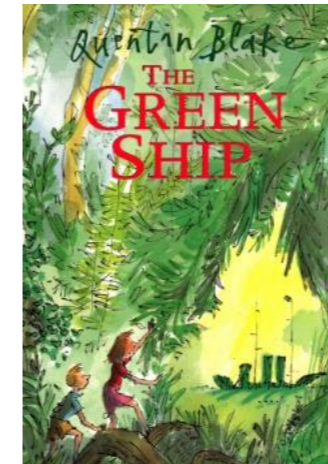

Expressive Arts and Design:

Music - Express thoughts and feelings about music giving more specific justifications.

Art - When drawing, use shading to create tone using an increasing awareness of composition (foreground /background). Experiment with different grades of pencil; from HB to 8B.

When painting, work on a range of scales, selecting the most appropriate sized brush e.g. thick brush for large work, thin brush for smaller areas.
